SPECIAL INFORMATION FOR AIRCRAFT EXHIBITORS AT AERO FRIEDRICHSHAFEN 2026



1. Registration of exhibition aircrafts

An overview / list of exhibiting aircraft will be published together with the index of exhibitors in the beginning of March. We kindly ask you to register your exhibiting aircraft at the Online Service Center. Visitors inform themselves in advance on our website. Please take the chance and attract attention.

Deadline: March 02, 2026

2. Dimensions and features of the hall doors

All our halls are provided with 3 <u>double wing doors</u>; one at the gable end and one at each long side of the halls. These doors have a clear width of 6.40 m. The individual wings can only be opened to the outside up to an angle of 90°. Every wing has a width of 3.43 m. Thus, it is only partly possible to "swivel" the aircraft into the hall. Please provide appropriate devices (e.g. dollies, etc.).

However, please note that the southward doors of hall A3, A4 and A7 as well as the northward door of hall B5 are an exception. These doors are designed as <u>sliding doors</u>. Furthermore, the southward doors of hall A3 and A4 have a clear width of 22 m; the southward door of hall A7 and the northward door of hall B5 have a clear width of 15 m.

3. Ground Handling Service

4. Ground Power Service

Fairnamic GmbH offers in cooperation with **Red Box International** free continuous and start power for aircraft on display. For further information please see order form ground power. Orders need to be placed until below mentioned date. Later orders can only be accepted on availability. Power connection need to be ordered separately.

In addition to that we also offer a chargeable service supplier AERO Fried. Order forms are in the Online Service Shop included.

5. Special information for the aircraft exhibitors in A and B halls

Please note that the arrival day of the exhibition aircraft depends on your placement and must be coordinated closely with the project team. The team commissioned by AERO Friedrichshafen, led by Thomas Schneider, will contact you to ensure a smooth arrival. We thank you in advance for your cooperation and support in this matter.

Since the official setup begins on Wednesday, April 15, 2026, delays and restrictions must generally be expected for deliveries after this date. Please also take note of the door dimensions of the halls (see point 2)!

6. Special information for the aircraft exhibitors on the static display:

Please note that the arrival day of the exhibition aircraft depends on your placement and must be coordinated closely with the project team. The team commissioned by AERO Friedrichshafen, led by Thomas Schneider, will contact you to ensure a smooth arrival. We thank you in advance for your cooperation and support in this matter.

7. Fees and Customs for exhibition aircraft

Take-off and landing fees for approaching exhibition aircraft above 4t MTOW are to be paid directly to Bodensee Airport Friedrichshafen (EDNY). Below 4t MTOW, FNC will cover the fees for AERO Friedrichshafen. Parking fees on airport areas as well as fees for further services of the airport operator or a handling agent will not be covered by FNC. Furthermore, we would like to point out that only the fees for those aircraft that are presented on the exhibition area will be covered. Fees for pick-up aircraft etc. are to be paid independently by the operator. It is the responsibility of the aircraft operator to organise the settlement with the airport operator.

For static display exhibitors with aircraft, AERO Friedrichshafen charges an aircraft handling fee of €300.00 per aircraft for ground handling, increased security precautions, and fencing.

Customs fees for exhibition aircraft of non-EU exhibitors, which are invoiced to the FNC, will be passed on to the exhibitors after AERO Friedrichshafen.

8. Arrival and Departure of exhibition planes during show period

Exhibition aircraft which need to start and depart from Bodensee airport Friedrichshafen during AERO show April 22-25, 2026, need a slot (also VFR) because during that time the PPR-regulation applies. This means especially the aircraft needing to depart at last show date April 25, 2026, after closing of the show at 04:00 p.m./ 2:00 UTC. Please register here for your departure slot:

You'll get access within 24h to the slot booking tool manually by the AERO team and can directly book your departure slot. For arrival, please select "arrival before the show ". Please only register when you need to depart on Saturday April 25th, 2026, for departure on following days no slot booking is necessary.

Please input pilot and passenger names in the slot booking. You can update the data until 3 hours before departure.



Please plan time slot according to the logistical circumstances. In case of doubt, please talk to your contact person of the booth, if not discussed already.

9. Customer demonstration flights

During the trade show exhibitors will be given the opportunity to organise demonstration flights for prospective customers (no public demonstration flights). These exhibitors are requested to keep a second aircraft ready at the airport.

In order to make sure that the required arrival and departure times for your customer demonstration flights are available please use the slot booking platform of Friedrichshafen Airport. See further information for departures and arrivals at the beginning of February.

Start/Landing and parking fees and all other flight related costs of the customer demonstration flights will be paid by the exhibitor. For further information please contact Bodensee Airport Friedrichshafen.

During the trade show, pilots arriving by ultralight aircraft may use nearby airfields such as Markdorf, Leutkirch or Mengen without needing a slot or prior permission

8. Emergency parachutes

We point out that the emergency parachutes of exhibited aircraft have to be mounted prior official hours and must stay in the same condition during the trade show in order to avoid injury to body or health and damage to the exhibition halls or third party property.
