

Marine Radio VHF Refresher Seminar, (without exams)

In this seminar you have the opportunity to:

- Refresh your knowledge from the SRC course.
- Practise speaking and using Pro-words in English again.
- As preparation for your next sailing trip, or SRC exam.
- Plenty of practise on proper VHF sets, the Icom M323



This refresher seminar will prepare you for your next sailing trip, giving you a more secure feeling. That is important, because at sea you will be participating in the whole maritime communication. Once you have left the marina, there will not be an opportunity to practise any more.

This seminar is also ideal for skippers preparing for their SRC course and exam.

This compact morning seminar without an exam, is conducted with a maximum of six people and duration of about 3,5 hours. Afterwards there is still enough time to visit the boatshow.

All switches and functions including subjects such as channels, distress, urgency, safety and routine communication will be explained again using the video-projector.

The VHF Icom M323 is used during the practical part of the seminar, at one set per person. All the sets are connected to each other, so communication between the sets is very realistic – just like at sea.

Below are some of the typical scenarios that are practised in English and discussed afterwards:

- Use of the phonetic alphabet and typical procedure words
- Calling a marina and asking for a berth
- You ask for a weather report
- You have engine problems in a busy shipping lane
- You observe a floating container. What message do you send and to who?
- A crew member is injured and you need medical advise
- You hear a distress call and message. What do you do?
- You send a DSC distress alert and message

The seminar commences at 10:15 and ends at about 13:30.
